

“Quilts for All Seasons” 2018 Quilt Show Rules

1. All exhibitors must be paid 2018 members of the Sheboygan County Quilt Guild. Membership is \$25.00. The SCQG welcomes any new members who would like to showcase their quilts. Registrations will be checked against the membership list.
2. Quilts entered must not have been shown in a previous SCQG show.
3. Quilts must be clean and odor free. Pay particular attention to this if you have a smoker in your household as many people find the smoke smell objectionable or allergies may be a problem for some of our guests. The check-in committee reserves the right to reject an entry that does not comply.
4. Registration forms and viewer's choice cards will be available at the June through September SCQG meetings, and from The Sewing Basket in Plymouth and Magpie's Cottage in Sheboygan Falls.
5. Review the quilt show categories and make sure you are choosing the correct category for each quilt. **The check-in committee reserves the right to re-categorize any quilt that is registered in an incorrect category.** Fill out the registration form completely by listing all the quilted items you plan to show and the dimensions of each one. Send the white copy of the registration form to Shannon Melius. Her address is on the form. **The mailed registration form must be received by Shannon on or before Monday, September 10th. Shannon will also be accepting forms at the September 12th SCQG meeting.**
Quilt registrations cannot be accepted after Sept. 12th for this year's show.
6. Fill out and attach one viewer's choice card to each quilt. Bring the viewer's choice card(s) and quilt(s) to check-in, along with the canary copy of the registration form. Keep the pink copy of the registration form. You will need the pink copy to pick up your quilts after the show.
7. Quilt check-in will be at Sheboygan County Christian High School, 929 Greenfield Avenue, Sheboygan, WI. on Friday, September 28th, between 4:30 to 5:30 PM. If you are unable to check-in your quilts during that time, you may have a friend bring them or you may drop your quilts and forms off at Magpie's Cottage in Sheboygan Falls or The Sewing Basket in Plymouth beginning Monday, September 24th through Thursday, September 27th. **If you drop your quilt(s) off at one of these shops, make sure they are in a plastic bag along with the necessary forms.**
8. **Please be mindful of all deadlines in consideration of all our volunteers.**
9. Quilt check-out will take place beginning at 4:15 PM on the day of the show.
* **Remember! Bring the pink copy of the registration form to claim your quilts.**
