

2018 “Quilts for All Seasons” QUILT SHOW Categories and ENTRY GUIDELINES

Selecting the proper category for your quilt(s) is an important part of every entry. Consider these guidelines when selecting a category. If you have any questions, bring your quilt to a meeting and we will help you. **The committee reserves the right to change any selections to a more appropriate category.** All items must be hand or machine quilted or hand-tied. Each quilt must have a top, batting and a backing. The term “bed quilt” refers to a twin, full, queen or king size quilt.

Viewer’s Choice Categories

Category #	Title	Description
100	Bed Quilt, Pieced	A bed quilt that is pieced and machine quilted by the maker.
200	Bed Quilt, Pieced	A bed quilt quilted by someone other than the maker.
300	Bed Quilt, Mixed	Mix of appliqué and piecing, machine quilted by the maker.
400	Bed Quilt, Mixed	Mix of appliqué and piecing, machine quilted by someone other than the maker.
500	Bed Quilt, Potpourri	Techniques such as crazy quilt, whole cloth, yoyo, etc.
600	Lap Quilts, Pieced	A quilt, smaller than a twin size, that is pieced.
700	Lap Quilts, Mixed	A quilt smaller than a twin size using mixed techniques.
800	Baby/Crib Quilts	A smaller quilt that is made for a baby or child. Mixed techniques.
900	Group Projects	Any size quilt that two or more have worked on. This does not include quilted by another or quilted by a professional.
1000	Machine Embroidered Quilts	Any quilt that has machine embroidery as a main focus.
1100	Wall Hanging, Pieced	A wall hanging made primarily by piecing.
1200	Wall Hanging, Mixed.	A wall hanging made by a combination of techniques including machine appliqué.
1300	Hand Work	Any size quilt that was primarily hand pieced, hand appliquéd and/or hand quilted.
1400	Theme Quilt	Any size, any technique that reflects the theme of this year’s quilt show.
1500	Original Art Quilt	Any size quilt that is designed by the maker. If a pattern or a photo was used as an inspiration, include a copy to be shown with the quilt. The finished quilt must differ from the original photo or pattern in a way that makes it one of a kind.
1600	Miniature Quilts	A small quilt that represents a scaled down version of a full sized bed quilt. Size should not exceed 30” x 30” with a maximum block size of 5 inches.
1700	Holiday	Any quilt, wall hanging or quilted item that has a holiday theme.
1800	Clothing/Fashion Accessories	Any quilted item that can be worn, done in any technique, including purses and totes.
1900	Home Accessories	Any quilted item used in the home in any technique. Items such as pillows, table runners, placemats, window treatments, etc. are included in this category.

Unjudged entries are any quilted items you wish to show but prefer not to have placed in the Viewer’s Choice Categories.
