

## AccuQuilt Go Fabric Cutting Machines Available for Community Use

Perfect quilts start with perfect cuts. One method of making perfect cuts is through the use of a fabric cutting machine. In 2018, Janice Worthey demonstrated the use of her Accuquilt fabric cutting machine at one of our guild meetings. Janice is willing to allow guild members use of her machine upon request *and* the Mead Library also has an Accuquilt Go Big Fabric Cutting Machine available for community use.

Mead's Accuquilt is available for anyone to use. Library card holders must view a demonstration by a library staff member or volunteer to learn to use the machine and to "get badged" for future independent use. Demonstrations are offered on Wednesdays from 4pm-7pm and on the second Saturdays of the month from 1pm-4pm. No appointment is needed, interested persons just need to stop by with their library card during one of these open sessions. Once badged, individuals can use the "Go Big!" when the library is open and there isn't another program scheduled in Mead's 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Imaginarium where the Accuquilt is kept.
