Sept. 24, 2022 Quilt Show Guidelines

“The love of quilting, just like gardening, is a seed once sown that never dies, but grows to the enduring happiness that the love of quilting gives.”

1. Please read all the guidelines carefully.
2. All exhibitors must be paid 2022 members of the Sheboygan County Quilters Guild. Membership is \$25.00. The SCQG welcomes any new members who would like to showcase their quilts. Registrations will be checked against the membership list.
3. By entering the SCQG 2022 Quilt Show you are agreeing that photos may be taken of your quilt projects and that the photos may be used in the SCQG newsletter, quilt show advertising, the SCQG website or the SCQG Facebook page.
4. Quilts entered must not have been shown in a previous SCQG show.
5. Quilts must be clean and odor free. Pay particular attention to this if you have a **smoker or pets** in your household as many people find smoke and pet odors objectionable or allergies may be a problem for some of our guests. The check-in committee reserves the right to reject an entry that does not comply. ***This also applies to all boutique items.***
6. Registration forms and viewer's choice cards will be available at the June, July, and August SCQG meetings, and from The Sewing Basket in Plymouth and Magpie's Cottage in Sheboygan Falls.
7. Review the quilt show categories and make sure you are choosing the correct category for each quilt. The check-in committee reserves the right to re-categorize any quilt that is registered in an incorrect category. Fill out the registration form completely, including a list of all the quilts you plan to show and the dimensions of each quilt. Send the **“white copy”** of the registration form to Shannon Melius. Her address is on the form. **The mailed registration form must be received by Shannon on or before Monday, September 1st. Shannon will also be accepting forms at the August 10 th SCQG meeting. Quilt registrations cannot be accepted after Sept.1st for this year's show.**
8. Fill out and attach one viewer's choice card to each quilt. Bring the completed viewer's choice description card(s) and quilt(s) to the check-in table at the high school, along with the completed **“canary copy”** of the registration form. Keep the pink copy of the registration form. You will need the pink copy to pick up your quilts after the show.
9. **Quilt check-in** will be at Sheboygan County Christian High School on Friday, September 23rd, between 4:30 and 5:30 PM. If you are unable to check-in your quilts during that time, you may have a friend bring them or you may drop your quilts and forms off at Magpie's Cottage in Sheboygan Falls or The Sewing Basket in Plymouth beginning Monday, September 19 th through Thursday, September 22 nd. **If you drop your quilt(s) off at one of these shops, make sure they are in a plastic bag along with the necessary forms.**
10. **Quilt check-out** will take place beginning at 4:15 PM on the day of the show.
*** Remember! Bring the “pink copy” of the registration form to claim your quilts. You will be escorted by a volunteer to retrieve your quilt entries. All quilts must be picked up by 5:30 PM. Thank you for your cooperation.**

Please be mindful of all deadlines in consideration of all our volunteers.
